This equated to over 750 hours of youth mentoring in a relaxed, fun environment that was enjoyed by so many. With most programming, evaluations are conducted at the end of the year. There was a noticeable trend with the student question, "What is the hardest thing about Lunch Buddies?" (at this point as the programmer, you take a deep breath and brace yourself)!

Mentoring is a rewarding opportunity to spend time with a young person. Currently, we have **5 Kinship Kids** waiting for mentors!


- » A 6-year-old male who likes pretending, arts & crafts, dinosaurs, farm toys, playing at the park, games, being read to and likes lots of different animals.
